Return from Winter Break

Our AESD schools will continue Distance Learning on January 11, 2021. All classes will begin at their regularly scheduled time on Monday.

In-Person Reopening Update

As a reminder, on December 9, 2020, the AESD Board approved a plan to delay the planned reopening of schools in response to the surging COVID-19 data in Anaheim and across Orange County. Our district will continue to monitor guidance from Governor Newsom, the Orange County Department of Education and the Orange County Health Care Agency regarding our planned dates for a safe return to in person instruction. At this time, the following schedules for a safe return to in person instruction will be implemented:

March 15, 2021

- Pre-school students return (1 day per week in person)
- PK-6 SDC students return (5 days per week in person)
- TK/K students return for blended learning (2 days per week in person)

March 22, 2021

 Grade 1-6 students return for blended learning (2 days per week in person)
