Dear AESD Families.

We truly hope that your children have enjoyed their first days of returning to full-day in-person instruction. The following update is provided to keep you informed regarding the Anaheim Elementary School District:

Our District continues to prioritize the health and safety of stakeholders as our top priority. Although California no longer reports data within the tiered colored system, as identified on the Orange County Health Care Agency website the COVID-19 case rates have risen for Orange County. This week, the City of Anaheim reported 527 new cases reported across Anaheim's seven ZIP codes for the seven days through August 17, down from 565 the week prior. It is important that we all remain vigilant in our safety protocols, continue to wear masks when in close proximity to others, frequently wash our hands; and seek testing when displaying any symptoms of COVID.

## Safer Gatherings During the Pandemic

As we continue to work towards preventing the spread of COVID-19, the CDC recommends that gathering virtually or with the people you live with is the safest choice for students when not in school. They recommend:

- Gathering with the people you live with only.
- If you do gather with people who don't live with you, gatherings and activities held outdoors are safer than indoor gatherings.
- Avoid crowded, poorly ventilated spaces.
