The following update is provided to keep you informed regarding the Anaheim Elementary School District:

Update on Weekly COVID-19 Data for Anaheim

Our District continues to prioritize the health and safety of stakeholders as our top priority. Although California no longer reports data within the tiered colored system, the City of Anaheim updates their data weekly. There were 199 new cases reported across Anaheim's seven ZIP codes for the seven days through Nov. 16, down from 247 the week prior.

If your child is experiencing COVID-19 symptoms, please keep him/her home and contact your child's health care provider. Please contact your school to report the absence; a COVID-19 related absence is excused. If someone in your household tested positive for COVID-19 and is currently under quarantine or self-isolation, your child should follow the guidelines from the Orange County Health Care Agency (OCHCA) on how long to remain at home and when to return to school.

Town Hall to Discuss Vaccinations

Last week we held a Town Hall to discuss the COVID 19 vaccination with Dr. Kate Williamson - CHOC pediatrician. We have included the following <u>link</u> to view the recorded informational event.

As a reminder, while the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) endorsed the recommendation that children 5 to 11 years old be vaccinated against COVID-19 on November 2nd, currently there is not a state mandate requiring that your child be vaccinated.

Upcoming COVID-19 Vaccination Clinic

For those families interested in accessing free COVID-19 vaccinations, Albertsons/Pavilions Pharmacies will host vaccination clinics on Saturday, December 4 at John Marshall, Key, and Orange Grove Elementary Schools from 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. for adult boosters and children 5-11 second shots. Parents will need to bring birth certificates for proof of age of the child. If registering for a booster, please bring proof of vaccination card for the parent. If you are gathering with a group of people from multiple households and potentially from different parts of the country, you could consider additional precautions (e.g., avoiding crowded indoor spaces before travel, taking a test) in advance of gathering to further reduce risk.
