The following update is provided to keep you informed regarding the Anaheim Elementary School District:

## Update on Weekly COVID-19 Data for Anaheim

Our District continues to prioritize the health and safety of stakeholders as our top priority. Although California no longer reports data within the tiered colored system, the City of Anaheim updates their data weekly. There were 7,345 new cases reported across Anaheim's seven ZIP codes for the seven days through January 18, up sharply from 5,404 the week prior.

If your child is experiencing COVID-19 symptoms, please keep him/her home and contact your child's health care provider. Please contact your school to report the absence; a COVID-19 related absence is excused. If someone in your household tested positive for COVID-19 and is currently under quarantine or self-isolation, your child should follow the guidelines from the Orange County Health Care Agency (OCHCA) on how long to remain at home and when to return to school.

## Free at-home COVID-19 Test Available for Families

Residential households can order one set of free at home tests. There is one order per address that can be processed and will include one order of four at-home Rapid Tests. Orders will ship in late January. Visit <u>covidtest.gov</u> to place your order for when you might need them.

## Redistricting Information Based on the 2020 Census

Due to a change in population from the 2010 to 2020 census, AESD will need to participate in the redistricting of trustee boundaries to support the balancing of total voting population per trustee area. The schools that can be affected by this new information are as follows: Orange Grove, Thomas Jefferson, Horace Mann, Olive Street, Ponderosa, Paul Revere, and Theodore Roosevelt. Each of the seven schools have held public forum meetings to ensure their school community is aware of potential changes that have been suggested by our demographers.

Our AESD website and each school website have posted the public forum informational meeting video and have drop boxes in their office to solicit feedback for the school board on potential redistricting scenarios.
