Dear AESD Families,

We hope that you are having an "amazing" and safe Winter Break. The following update is provided to keep you informed regarding the Anaheim Elementary School District:

Update on Weekly COVID-19 Data for Anaheim

Our District continues to place the health and safety of stakeholders as our top priority. Although California no longer reports data within the tiered colored system, the City of Anaheim updates their data weekly. There were 2,923 new cases reported across Anaheim's seven ZIP codes for the seven days through Jan. 4, up sharply from 904 the week prior.

If your child is experiencing COVID-19 symptoms, please contact your child's health care provider. Please contact your school to report the positive results; based on the necessary quarantine period if your child needs to miss school, a COVID-19 related absence is excused. If someone in your household tested positive for COVID-19 and is currently under quarantine or self-isolation, your child should follow the guidelines from the Orange County Health Care Agency (OCHCA) on how long to remain at home and when to return to school.

Free Take Home COVID-19 Testing Kits for All Students

In an effort to reduce COVID-19 transmission in schools as the Omicron variant surges nationwide, the California Department of Public Health is making at-home COVID-19 testing kits available for free to local families, who are encouraged to test students returning from winter break. All AESD schools have received a supply of COVID-19 antigen tests that will be available for pick up and voluntary use as an added precaution.

AESD students will get a box with two tests. That will allow each student to be tested twice as they return to school in January.

The state has developed flyers in <u>English</u> and <u>Spanish</u> that explain when to test your child and what steps to take if you get a positive test result. More information can be found on the <u>CDPH website</u>.

Information on how and when to pick up a test kit for your child will be communicated by each school directly to its families. But first we want to call attention to a couple key points:

- There is no statewide testing mandate for students returning to school. While some school districts in California may implement local testing policies, the state is not requiring a documented negative test to return to the classroom. The CDPH says its efforts are intended to increase access to tests for K-12 students.
- There is no cost to families. The tests have been purchased by the California Department of Public Health with funds provided by the federal government to support testing in schools.

Reminder: COVID-19 Testing at Key Elementary School

For those families that are unable to pick-up the available COVID-19 take home tests; you are reminded that COVID-19 testing will be available at Key Elementary School every day this week through Friday, January 7, 2022. Testing is available from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and from 1:00 p.m. - 5:00 p.m. The Key testing clinic will now also be open on Saturday, January 8, from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Click <u>here</u> to sign up for an appointment and complete the online consent form. **Please note that this testing site is for AESD students and staff only**.

While COVID-19 tests are not mandatory for returning students, we encourage you to take advantage of this opportunity to help provide extra safety and peace of mind as we navigate this stage of the pandemic. Moreover, the steps we take together can help ensure the safest possible learning environment for all of our students. All families are asked to get your child tested or take advantage of the take home tests before returning to school on January 10.
