


- Validated redistricting data was finalized by the California Department of Finance on September 27, 2021.
- This data showed substantial changes in the area served by Anaheim Elementary School District (“AESD”) from 2010 to 2020, including:
 - Overall population growth of over 6,051 (3.1%)
 - Total Variance of 18.0% based on 2020 Census (*Out of Compliance*)





Compact and contiguous, as much as possible



SCENARIO 1 - CONSIDERATIONS


- Scenario 1 was drawn in consideration of minor boundary adjustments by decreasing Area 4 and expanding Area 5 to bring the District back into compliance. In this scenario, Roosevelt Elementary School moved from Area 4 to Area 5.
- A noteworthy detail is within Areas 1, 4, and 5, which are based on total population and CVAP data, there are 3 majority Hispanic/Latino Areas and 5 areas that are plurality Hispanic Areas.
- Scenario 1 has the largest variance of 7.9%.

SCENARIO 2 - CONSIDERATIONS


- Scenario 2 was drawn in consideration of minor boundary adjustments by moving Jefferson Elementary School into Area 1, Mann Elementary School into Area 2 from Area 1, and by balancing the number of schools within each Area.
- A noteworthy detail is within Areas 1, 2, 4, and 5, which are based on total population and CVAP data, there are 4 majority Hispanic/Latino Areas and 5 areas that are plurality Hispanic Areas.
- Scenario 2 has the lowest variance of 6.3%.

- A noteworthy detail is within Areas 1, 4, and 5, which are based on total population and CVAP data, there are 3 majority Hispanic/Latino Areas and 5 areas that are plurality Hispanic Areas.
- Scenario 3 has a variance of 7.7%.
