We hope that you enjoyed our recent Spring Break! The following update is provided to keep you informed regarding the Anaheim Elementary School District:

Update on Weekly COVID-19 Data for Anaheim

Our District continues to prioritize the health and safety of stakeholders as our top priority. Although California no longer reports data within the tiered colored system, the City of Anaheim updates their data weekly. For the seven days through April 19, Anaheim saw 134 new cases, up from 116 a week earlier.

If your child is experiencing COVID-19 symptoms, please keep him/her home and contact your child's health care provider. Please contact your school to report the absence; a COVID-19 related absence is excused. If someone in your household tested positive for COVID-19 and is currently under quarantine or self-isolation, your child should follow the <u>guidelines</u> from the Orange County Health Care Agency (OCHCA) on how long to remain at home and when to return to school.

Update on COVID-19 Vaccine Requirements

The California Department of Public Health (CDPH) issued the following statement regarding a new implementation timeline for adding the COVID-19 vaccine to the list of vaccinations required to attend school.

Statement on Timeline for COVID-19 Vaccine Requirements in Schools

SACRAMENTO – To ensure sufficient time for successful implementation of new vaccine requirements, California will not initiate the regulatory process for a COVID-19 vaccine requirement for the 2022-2023 school year and as such, any vaccine requirements would not take effect until after full FDA approval and no sooner than July 1, 2023.

Vaccines are the most powerful weapon against hospitalization and serious illness due to COVID-19. California's response to conditions in schools has adapted to the dynamic challenges of the pandemic, based on science.

COVID-19 Home Tests

At home tests may be used to report a positive COVID-19 case but may not be used to shorten the 10-day quarantine. If your child has tested positive and tests on day five or later to return to school, the test must be performed at a clinic with results that have your child's name and birthdate on it. Children who test positive for COVID may return to school after day 10 without a negative COVID test as long as symptoms have improved and they have been fever free for 24 hours or more.
