## Update on Weekly COVID-19 Data for Anaheim

Our District continues to prioritize the health and safety of stakeholders as our top priority. Although California no longer reports data within the tiered colored system, the City of Anaheim updates their data weekly. For the seven days through May 24, Anaheim saw 563 new cases, up from 404 a week earlier.

As the school year comes to a close there are a lot of celebratory gatherings. Please continue to be vigilant. The CDPH strongly recommends masking indoors and seeking testing when displaying any symptoms of COVID-19. You can review the current safety measures from the state <u>here</u>.

## COVID-19 Vaccines

Per the CDC there are many <u>benefits of getting vaccinated</u> against COVID-19.

• COVID-19 vaccines are effective at protecting people from getting seriously ill and being hospitalized - especially people who are boosted.

- You are protected best when you <u>stay up to date</u> with the recommended number of doses and boosters. As of May 19, the CDC now recommends that children ages
  5-11 receive a booster shot five months after their initial vaccination series.
- COVID-19 vaccines offer protection to people who had COVID-19, including protection against being hospitalized from a new infection.
- COVID-19 vaccines are safe much safer than getting COVID-19.

The OC Health Care Agency has several <u>educational videos</u> about COVID-19 and vaccine safety and effectiveness. The District will continue to host vaccine clinics sending details to all families as they are finalized. ## At Home COVID-19 Tests

Thank you for helping keep our school environment safe throughout the school year. On Friday, May 27, each student will bring home two COVID-19 at home test kits. A COVID test is recommended to be completed on Monday, May 30, by 5:00 PM. If negative your child can return to school on Tuesday, May 31. Please report positive cases to the school office.
