Update on Weekly COVID-19 Data for Anaheim

Our District continues to prioritize the health and safety of stakeholders as our top priority. Although California no longer reports data within the tiered colored system, the City of Anaheim updates their data weekly. For the seven days through June 7, Anaheim saw 905 new cases, up from 669 a week earlier.

As the school year comes to a close there are a lot of celebratory gatherings. Please continue to be vigilant. The CDPH strongly recommends masking indoors and seeking testing when displaying any symptoms of COVID-19. You can review the current safety measures from the state here.
